## Corporate Social Resposibility

Skills Training and Management (Pvt) Ltd



Skills Training & Management (Pvt) Ltd was formed in December 2005 as an associate company of Sanken Construction (Pvt) Ltd. The current registration number of the company is PV 11431. The company premises are conveniently located at Pahala Bomiriya Kaduwela, & are within easy walking distance from the AB 010 Colombo-Hanwella Low-Level Road. The distance from the main bus stand in Kaduwela to the above premises on Colombo -Hanwella Road is approximately 01 kilometer.

The Company was registered with the Tertiary & Vocational Education Commission (TVEC) as a provider of vocational training (Registered No Po1/0311) under the National Vocational Qualifications (NVQs) framework on 22 November 2006. NVQs are National Competency Standards (NCS) achieved through Competency Based Training (CBT) as well as through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).

- The objectives of Skills Training & Management (Pvt) Ltc include but not limited to the following.
- To provide requisite institutional training as well as on the job training for the new entrants to the construction industry to enable them to acquire requisite skills based on National Competency Standards.
- To provide advanced skills training for those who are in the same occupations to enable them to meet the output standards required by the relevant National Competency Standards established by TVEC.
- To provide supplementary training for those workers who prefer to change their occupations or to gain wider knowledge & skill of their respective trades.
- To conduct short-term courses to provide necessary theoretical training for those who acquire skill competency through on the job practical training.







- To provide guidance & training for external candidates
  to enable them to take assessments being conducted
  by TVEC (Tertiary & Vocational Education Commission)
  or NAITA (National Apprentice & Industrial Training
  Authority) with to acquire National Vocational
  Qualifications on their respective trades through RPL
  (Recognition of Prior Learning) / CBT
  (Competency-Based Training) assessments.
- To develop occupational skill standards pertaining to the newly emerging trades in the construction industry & submit them for approval by the TVEC.
- To conduct appropriate short-term courses to meet the requirements of the construction industry.

In Sri Lanka, construction skills are still mainly acquired through an informal training system and the construction industry is having difficulty in recruiting new workers especially unemployed young people. There is evidence to indicate that construction workers do not view their employment in a very favourable light. Jobs that involve manual work in the construction industry are regarded as low-status jobs. The inability of the industry to attract our country's youth and invest them in vocational training has serious repercussions for the productivity and quality of construction products and hence for the ability of contractors to satisfy their clients' needs.

Labour shortages and lack of skills can also create pressures to replace labour with machines, through prefabrication and mechanization, thereby threatening







the long-term potential of the construction industry to generate much-needed employment. Further, there exists an increasing demand for skilled construction workers for foreign employment and the Sri Lanka Bureau of Foreign Employment promotes skilled worker migration.

Skills Training & Management (Pvt) Ltd, was established for the express purpose of making a substantial contribution to the local construction industry by providing its services for recruiting suitable young people and providing them with appropriate vocational training with on modern construction methods so that the training acquired by them would stand them in good stead for securing gainful employment.

The company as a provider of vocational training aims to help create a well-disciplined & skilled workforce to meet the requirements of the Sanken Group of Companies in particular & of the local construction industry in general. Skills Training & Management (Pvt) Ltd has obtained institutional registration and course accreditation from the TVEC to conduct several full-time vocational training courses.





Trainees who Redundant complete the Construction Supervisor (Site Administration) Training Course (NVQ Level 4) are groomed to function as Assistant Engineers in the fullness of time. The above course is a full-time training course comprising a 06 months institutional training period followed by a 09 months on-job training period.

Infrastructure facilities of Skills Training & Management (Pvt) Ltd include a 115-seat capacity air-conditioned auditorium equipped with modern audio-visual equipment, lecture halls, classrooms, workshops, and accommodation for residential trainees.

The courses that have been registered with TVEC include vocational training courses on the following categories of personnel. Construction Site Supervisor NVQ IV, Safety & Health Officer NVQ III, Storekeeper NVQ III.

Construction Craftsman (Masonry) NVQ II III, Bar Bender NVQ II III, Wood craftsman NVQ II III, Plumber NVQ II III, Setting out assistant NVQ II.


Skills Training & Management (Pvt) Ltd is registered with the Sri Lanka Bureau of Foreign Employment as a Foreign Employment Agency and has a valid licence to carry on the business of a foreign employment agency. The company can recruit and dispatch skilled manpower required for overseas construction projects undertaken by the Sanken Group of Companies.

The trainees who follow vocational training courses at Skills Training & Management (Pvt) Ltd have the advantage of securing on the job training at construction sites coming under the operational and administrative control of Sanken Construction (Pvt). The company maintains a well-disciplined workforce for employment on construction projects undertaken by its holding company, Sanken Construction (Pvt) Ltd.

In recognition of the company's (Skills Training & Management (Pvt) Ltd) contribution to the construction industry as a provider of vocational training and the company's business association with Sanken Lanka (Pvt) Ltd, the establishment of Skills Training and Management (Pvt) Ltd as an associate company of Sanken Lanka (Pvt) Ltd was recognized by the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce as a CSR Project.

A Merit award - Training & Education under the category "Special Projects on Corporate Social Responsibility" was presented in 2008 to Sanken Lanka (Pvt) Ltd by the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce. The name of the company was subsequently changed from Sanken Lanka (Pvt) Ltd to Sanken Construction (Pvt) Ltd.
